

## **STUDENTS**

### Assignment to Classes

Placement in classes shall be based upon consideration of the best interests of the individual student and also the effect on the instructional setting.

In the case of transfer students, it is within the Building Principal's authority to assign a student to a learning setting other than that recommended by the transferring school.

1. The District retains the absolute right for assignment of all students.
2. If necessary, the parent(s)guardian(s), teacher, student (when appropriate), and the Principal shall meet to consider appropriate placement at grade level.
3. Criteria to be used for placement may include, but not to be limited to the following:
  - A. District administered achievement tests.
  - B. Results of District criteria referenced tests.
  - C. Records from previous school enrollment.
4. The Building Principal or his designee shall be included in discussions regarding the placement of students from his building in special Education classes.
